Dear Mr. Ward:

Under the authority of the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act (La. R.S. 30:2001 *et seq.*), I hereby issue the enclosed Standard Type III Permit for the above-referenced facility.

Upon implementation of permit requirements and completion of construction, a qualified professional must certify that the facility has implemented procedures and/or has been constructed in accordance with the representations made in the permit application and all conditions specified in this Standard Permit.

Upon receipt of the Standard Permit, the facility will complete all upgrading as required by the permit and/or complete all construction measures, and submit a certification by a registered engineer, licensed in the State of Louisiana. An initial start-up inspection will be conducted by the Permits Division within ten (10) working days of the acceptance of the engineer's certification by the Office of Environmental Assessment, Environmental Technology Division.

Please note that in accordance with LAC 33:VII.509.C.4, within fifteen (15) working days after the start-up inspection, the Permits Division will issue an order authorizing commencement of operations or a written Notice of Deficiency to the permittee. Also, an Order to Commence Operations must be obtained from the Department prior to commencement of operations.

This permit action shall become final and not subject to further administrative review unless, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of this document, a written request for a hearing is filed. Provisions of this permit may be appealed in writing pursuant to La. R. S. 30:2024(A) within thirty (30) days from receipt of the permit. Only those provisions specifically appealed will be

suspended by a request for a hearing, unless the Secretary elects to suspend other provisions as well. A request must be directed to the following:



A copy of this request should be sent to the Permits Division.

In accordance with LAC 33:VII.513.H, the permit holder shall publish a notice of the issuance of the Standard Permit no later than (10) days following the issuance of the permit. This notice shall be published in the official journal of the state and in the official journal of the parish where the facility is located. The Permittee will furnish a certified copy of these notices to the Department.

STANDARD SOLID WASTE TYPE III PERMIT

Pursuant to the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act (La. R. S. 30:2001 *et seq.*; "the Act") as amended, and the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 33, Part VII, a Standard Type III Permit is issued to:

(Hereinafter referred to as the "Permittee")


Limitations and conditions applicable to this Standard Permit:

1. This Standard Permit applies only to the Highway 90 C & D Landfill (hereinafter referred to as the "Facility"), located on U.S. Highway 90, 1 mile west of Live Oak Boulevard Sections 9 & 39, Township 13 South, Range 22 East in Waggaman, Jefferson Parish, Louisiana.
2. Upon completion of all construction and implementation of all measures as presented in the permit application, a certification by a qualified professional must be given to the Secretary certifying that the Facility has been constructed in accordance with the representations made in the permit application accepted by the Permits Division and all conditions of this Standard Permit
3. Prior to beginning operation, the Permittee shall obtain all other applicable permits, licenses, or authorizations as may be required by local, state or federal agencies.
4. Prior to beginning operation under this permit, the Permittee must notify the Permits Division so that an inspection can be made in accordance with LAC 33:VII.509.C.1 & 2. The Permits Division shall initiate all start-up inspections within ten (10) working days of receipt of certification unless a longer time period is agreed upon.
5. Within fifteen (15) working days after the initial start-up inspection, the Permits Division shall issue an order authorizing commencement of operation or written Notice of Deficiency to the Permittee.
6. The operation of the Facility is subject to all applicable rules and regulations and orders of the Permits Division and all conditions of this Standard Permit.

7. The operation of the Facility shall be in accordance with the representations made in the permit application accepted by the Permits Division and all conditions of this Standard Permit.
8. The estimated date of final closure of the Facility as provided in LAC 33:VII.521.J of the permit application is to be used for the purpose of projecting the Facility's potential capacity. This Standard Permit expires on 11-05-2014, by which time the facility shall be closed in accordance with the closure plan outlined in the permit application or the Permittee shall have submitted an application for obtaining a new permit for operation of the facility at least 455 days prior to the permit's expiration.
9. No modification to the site, facility, process or disposal method or operation may be effected without prior approval of the Secretary in accordance with LAC 33:VII.517.A.
10. Failure to operate the Facility in accordance with the Act, the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 33, Part VII, or this Standard Permit shall constitute a violation, which will subject Permittee to the possible imposition of civil penalties in accordance with LAC 33:VII. Chapter 9 and Section 2025 of the Act; and to the possible suspension or revocation of this Standard Permit in accordance with LAC 33:VII.511.H.
11. Prior to beginning operations, all financial information required by LAC 33:VII.521.L and the applicable standards in LAC 33:VII.727 shall be submitted to the Department for approval.
