## RCRA EMPTY CONTAINER CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify to the best of my knowledge, the containers that once held \_\_\_\_\_, represented by Waste Profile No. \_\_\_\_\_, were never used to store PCB's (pursuant to 40CFR Parts 261 and 761 and meet the following definition of "EMPTY" [pursuant to 40CFR 261.7(b)(1)(2)(3)]:

1. A container that has held a waste or product, except a waste or product that is a compressed gas of that is identified as an acute hazardous waste listed in 261.31, 261.32, 261.33(e), of 40CFR 261, is "EMPTY" if:
    - a. All waste has been removed using the practices commonly employed to remove materials from that type container (i.e. pouring, pumping, and aspirating), AND
    - b. No more than one inch (2.5 centimeters) of residue remains on the bottom of the container, OR
    - c. I. No more than 3 percent by weight of the total capacity of the container remains in the container if the container is  $\leq$  110 gallons in size, or  
II. No more than 0.3 percent by weight of the total capacity of the container remains in the container remains in the container if the container is  $>$  110 gallons in size.
  2. A container that has held a waste or product that is a compressed gas is empty when the container approaches atmospheric pressure.
  3. A container that has held acute hazardous waste listed in 261.31, 261.32, or 261.33(e) is empty if the container has been triple rinsed.
